- Interested applicants who require IAEA TC support may contact the National Liaison Officers (NLOs) in their respective country. With the NLO's consent, applicants may submit their application directly to the Phoenix Leader Education Program Office, Hiroshima University as per the academic requirements.
- Applicants should indicate in the motivation letter that they are applying with the consent of the National Liaison Officer (NLOs) responsible for the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme in their respective country.
- Hiroshima University will evaluate the applications and notify the result of 1st selection to the applicants via email. The applicants who have passed the 1st selection shall have the oral examination regarding the academic discipline, element of leadership, English proficiency, etc. The notification of admission will be sent to the applicants via email and postal mail.
- Subject to the academic acceptance of the University, and to be considered for a fellowship support, the applicants will thereafter be required to complete the IAEA Fellowship Application through InTouch+ under the relevant national or regional project for the approval of the National Liaison Officer (NLOs) who will submit to IAEA the request as per the official channel.
- Upon receiving the Fellowship Applications endorsed by NLOs, IAEA will proceed with the processing of the request according to the existing procedures for fellowships.
- Applicants are advised to note and adhere to the deadline requirements issued by the University. The official Application Guide for Admission is now announced by Hiroshima University in their Web site below.
